



Your First Bareboat Charter

You made it !! You have completed all the courses necessary to be able to bareboat charter with Spinnaker Sailing. Here is some important information that will help you on your first Bareboat Charter. PLEASE READ THIS!

- ✓ Bareboat Charter: You take full ownership of the boat while it is in your possession, so if anything happens to the vessel you are 100% responsible no matter what.
- ✓ Your First Bareboat Must be on a Santana 22' (not Qu'Appelle) and start at 9am. No exceptions
- ✓ Always Remember to Sail with the Current, Not Against it. If it will be ebbing in the afternoon, sail towards the South Bay so you can come home with the tide, versus fight it. Remember, there can be upwards of 4 knots of current on SF Bay. Maximum speed of a Santana 22 is 4.5 knots!
- ✓ You Must Stay South of Pier 39 on your First Charter. No Exceptions. If you are seen North of Pier 39 you will be operating without insurance and fully liable for the boat and any injuries.
- ✓ Boat MUST be brought back 1 hour Prior to Sunset. There are no running lights on your boat and the Coast Guard will issue you a citation for not having running lights. The citation will be yours to pay.
- ✓ We provide enough fuel to motor in and out of the Harbor, otherwise you should be sailing, the motors are not designed to run for long periods of time. Remember 20% of the horsepower (and fuel economy) gets you 80% of the boats speed. The rest of the horsepower is just wasted gas.
- ✓ Only in Emergencies where you are not able to sail the vessel, you may call Vessel Assist but note there may be a charge and Spinnaker is not responsible for this. 1(800) 367-8222. Make sure you tell Vessel Assist you are a charterer, not the owner.
