WHAT TO BRING

On Your Sailing Adventure

WELCOME ABOARD!

Your entire crew would like to welcome you aboard for an exciting sail on the Bay!

So that you will have a most enjoyable cruise, please read the following important information:

Weather and sailing conditions can vary substantially from hour to hour, therefore, it is very important to be prepared!

All of the boats have comfortable interiors, so you can get out of the weather.

On regatta programs, it is a good idea to bring clothing that can be put on in layers, Remember, we'll be sailing and even on a warm day, the wind chill can cool it off on the water.

Sunscreen, sunglasses (with eyeglass cords), and possibly a hat are highly recommended at all times during daylight hours. If you forget these items, we sell them in our Office at the Harbor.

If the weather is a little overcast or drizzly in the morning on the day you plan to sail with us, don't worry! The weather usually tends to clear up in the

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We're located at Pier 40 in the South Beach Harbor, San Francisco.

Please turn this page over for directions and a map to our location at South Beach Harbor.

Please note: Pier 40 is not located next to Pier 39. All odd numbered piers are north of the Bay Bridge. Pier 40 is South of the Bay Bridge, (about 1/2 mile)

There is very limited public parking on the Pier 40 lot. Please do not park in any stall labeled "permit only". Refer to parking options on the back of this flyer.

Footwear should be comfortable, with light colored soles. Topsiders or sneakers are ideal. No black soled or street shoes please!

DIRECTIONS TO SOUTH BEACH HARBOR

REMEMBER. Baseball Days will be VERY congested in and around the harbor. Call us for the schedule and "clear traffic" times. Generally expect heavy traffic 1 hour prior and 1 hour post game and very light traffic during the game.

FROM THE EAST BAY - Follow I-80 across the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge. Take the Fremont Street Exit (first exit off the bridge) and follow the exit toward Folsom St.. Turn left onto Folsom. Follow to Embarcadero, turn right. Head about 1/2 mile South to Pier 40. Turn left on Townsend onto the Pier.

FROM THE PENINSULA - Take US 101 North. About 1 mile north of Candlestick Park, take the "280 North - Port of San Francisco" exit. Follow 280 to the last offramp (King Street). King turns into Embarcadero. Go up about 1/2 mile to Pier 40, at the intersection of Townsend and Embarcadero. Park on the street or in the designated visitor stalls.

FROM SAN FRANCISCO - Take Embarcadero South along the Waterfront. South Beach Harbor is located at the intersection of Townsend and Embarcadero on Pier 40, 1/2 mile South of the Bay Bridge.

FROM MARIN COUNTY - Take US 101 South across the Golden Gate Bridge. Take the Marina exit. Follow the waterfront to Bay Rd., turn left. Head East on Bay to the end, turn right on Embarcadero. Head South on Embarcadero past the Bay Bridge to Pier 40. Park on the street or in the designated visitor stalls.

PUBLIC PARKING INFORMATION

Metered Parking – Good public parking is available around this location (25¢ per half hour). Due to the proximity to SBC Park, these on-street parking spaces will be more difficult to park in during the baseball season

South Beach Harbor Parking Lots. Contact the Harbormaster at 415-495-4911 for \$10 day permits.

Bryant St. & Embarcadero Parking Lot – Corner of Bryant St and Embarcadero St.: This parking lot has 545 spaces, is open 24 hours a day with an attendant on site until 6:00 p.m. unless there is a game and then there is a attendant until 11:00 p.m., and they charge a flat rate of \$8.00 per car unless a game or other event is happening when they then charge \$15.00 per car.

175 Townsend St. Parking Lot– They charge a \$6.00 flat rate per car and are open from 7:00 a.m.to 6:00 p.m. (except for baseball games \$20-30).

178 Townsend St. Parking Lot– This garage is open from 7:00 a.m.to 7:00 p.m. (except for baseball games \$20-30).

Stanford & 2nd Parking Lot– 680 Stanford St and 635 2nd St.: These two lots are run by the same company and are open from 6:00 a.m.to 6:00 p.m. (except for baseball games \$20-30).

Please make sure to give yourself plenty of time to find parking if you have not arranged motorcoach transportation. The boat only waits 5 minutes or so for late comers.

PUBLIC TRANSIT INFORMATION

FROM THE EAST BAY :

Take BART to the first San Francisco station Embarcadero. Walk up one level to MUNI and take the N-Line South. Get off at either Brannan or Second street station and walk to Pier 40 (about 3 minutes). You can also walk from BART heading south down the Embarcadero along the waterfront promenade (15-25 minutes).

FROM THE PENINSULA:

Take CalTrain to the last station, Fourth & Townsend. Walk up King or Townsend streets to Pier 40, South Beach Harbor.

FROM SAN FRANCISCO:

Muni Buses- Take the #32 (Embarcadero) or the #42

Muni Rail- E Line (from Fisherman's Wharf) N Line (from Market st./BART)

FROM MARIN COUNTY:

Take Golden Gate Transit (either boat or bus)
