ASA 101 BASIC KEELBOAT SAILING 1 & 2

NEW for 2022! This course is designed for the beginning sailor who is interested in learning the fundamentals of sailing, as well as skills for efficient boat handling and control. Taught on the Andrews 21. This is the course curriculum for ASA 101 Certification.

ASA 103 BASIC COASTAL CRUISING

This class is a continuation of ASA BKS program. Each of the 4 lessons consist of 5 hours of onboard instruction. Classes are taught aboard the incredible J/80 or SC-27. This is the course curriculum for ASA 103 Certification, graduates are able to charter boats up to 27' in length once they complete ASA 118a.

Basic Coastal Cruising starts 1st and 3rd weekends and can only be taken on two consecutive weekends. Midweek Class taught Mon-Wed 11-5pm

ASA104 INTERMEDIATE COASTAL CRUISE

This course is for graduates of Basic Coastal Cruising, or those demonstrating equivalent experience. The class is taught aboard a 35' sailboat and focuses upon large boat handling, boat systems, navigation, and charter planning. Classes run Saturday and Sunday, full day. This is the course curriculum for ASA 104 Certification. ASA 118b (docking & boat handling) and ASA 105 (coastal navigation) are pre-req to charter.

Intermediate Coastal Cruising is taught the 3rd weekend of the month. 2 days, 9am - 5pm aboard the FAST J/105

ASA 118 DOCKING & BOAT HANDLING

This one-day class covers an amazing amount of docking, maneuvering, boat handling, engine operation and troubleshooting information. 118a focuses on outboards and 118b focuses on inboard diesels. Lots of practical experience maneuvering the sailboat incorporated into each class. Both classes required for full ASA 118 certification.

HIGH WIND ENDORSEMENT
