Students should bring foul weather gear (at least a water-proof jacket) and wear deck boots, tennis or deck shoes (no black soles please).

We will be sailing in the slot around Alcatraz and you are likely to get wet. Now is the time to buy some foul weather gear... at least a jacket. Upon Graduation you will be certified to bareboat charter the J/80 East of the Golden Gate.
